Before you can signal you are in trouble your regulator quits delivering air.

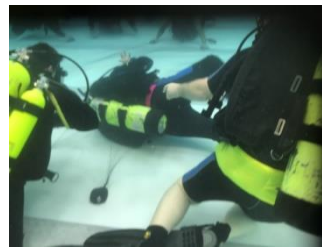
What will you do? What CAN you do?
